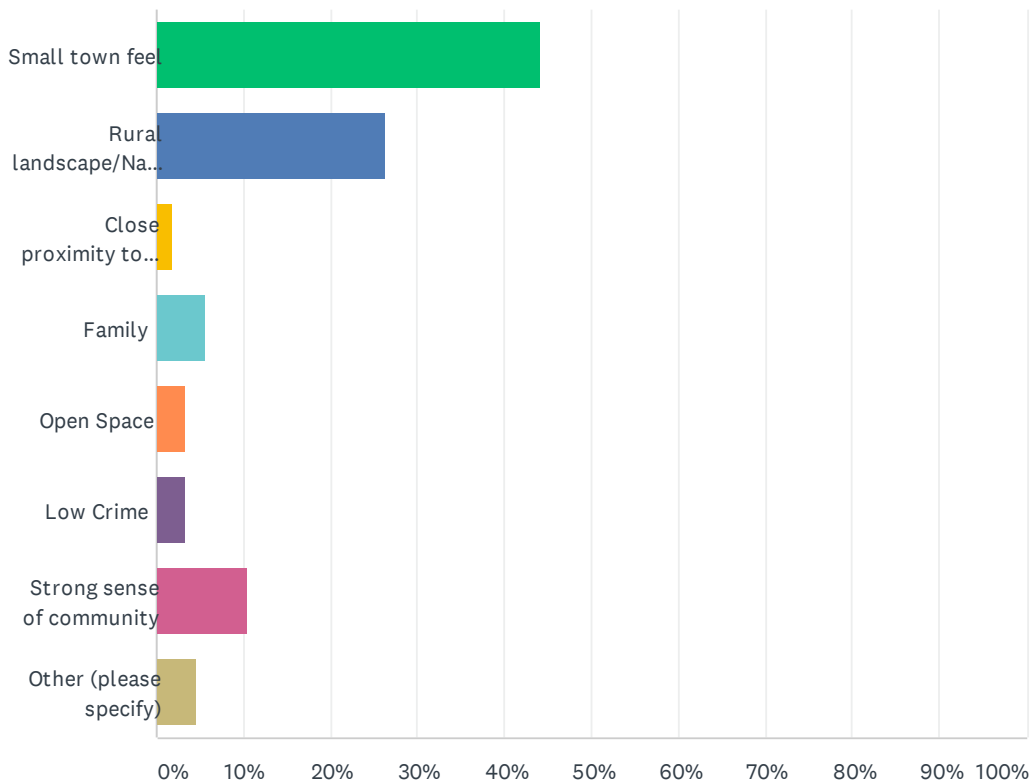


Q1 What's Your Favorite Thing About Stafford?

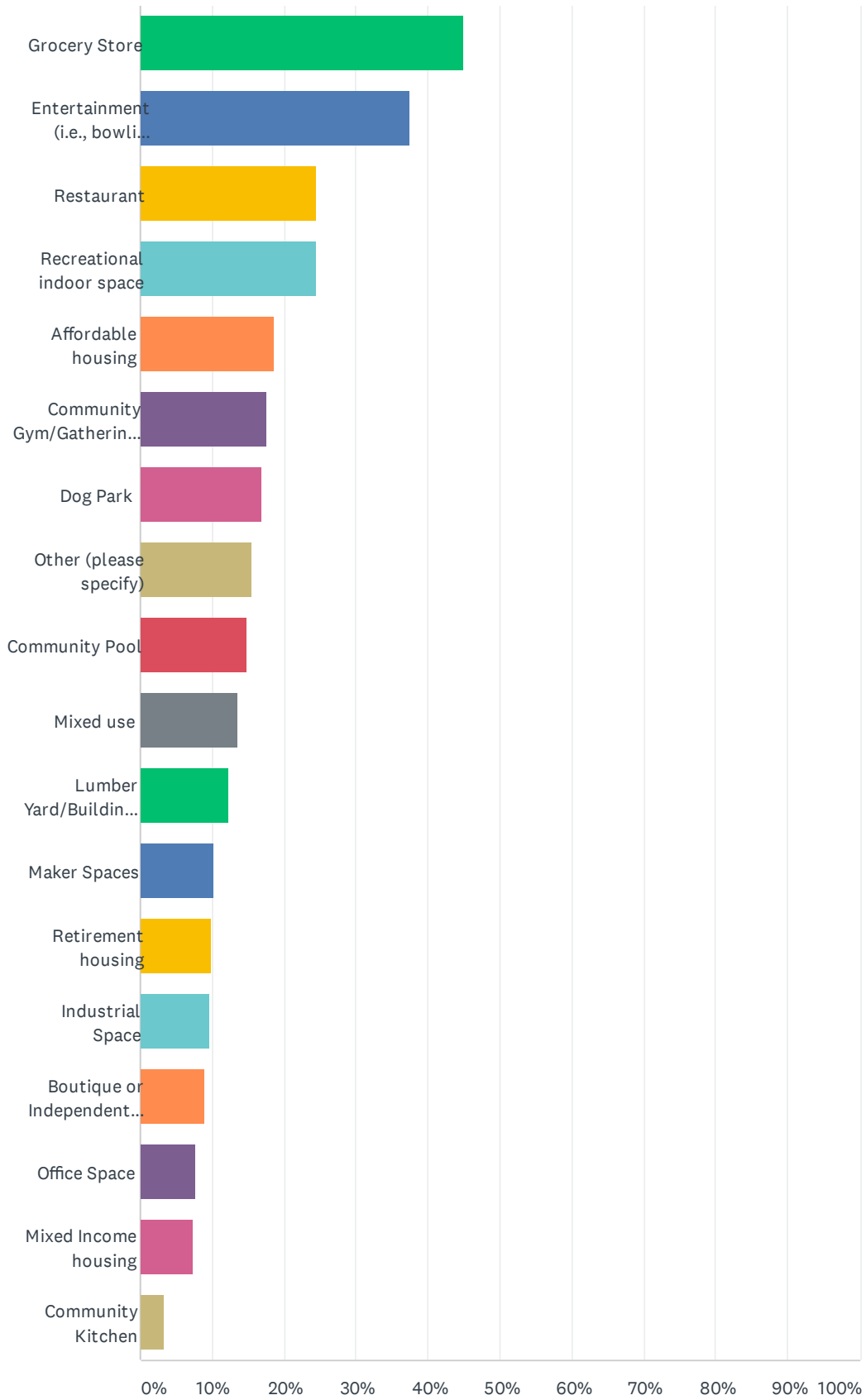

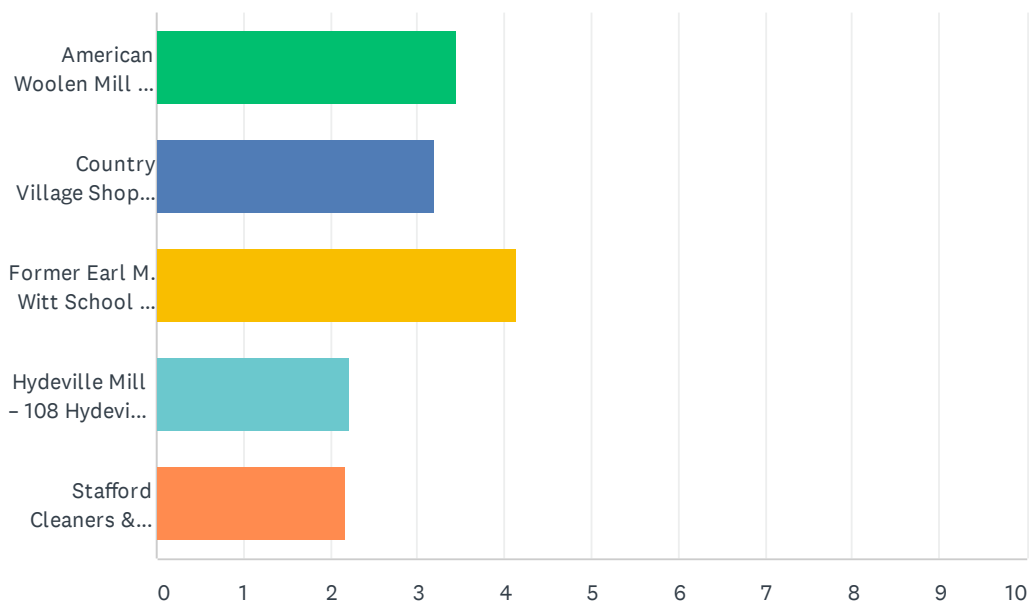

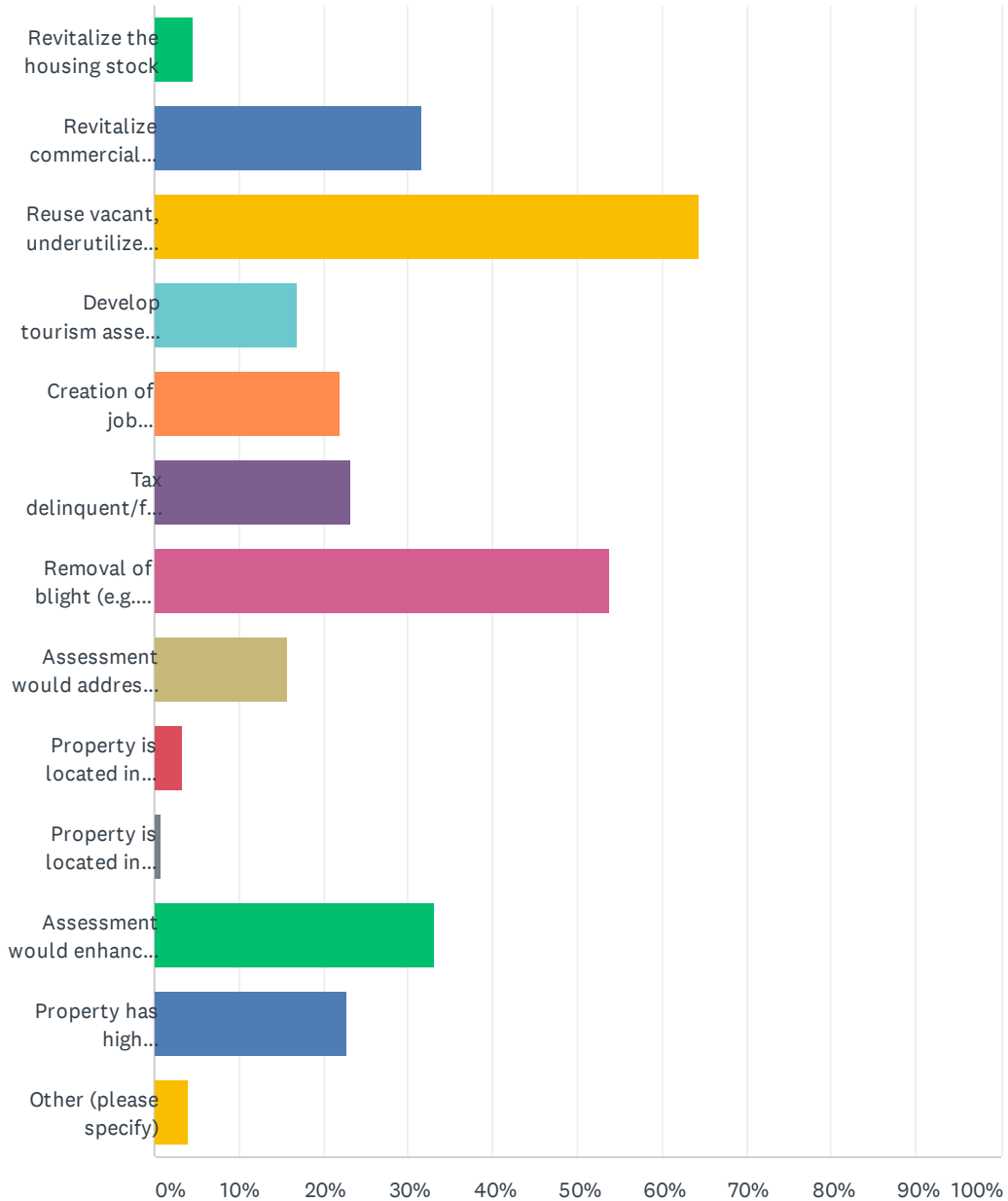

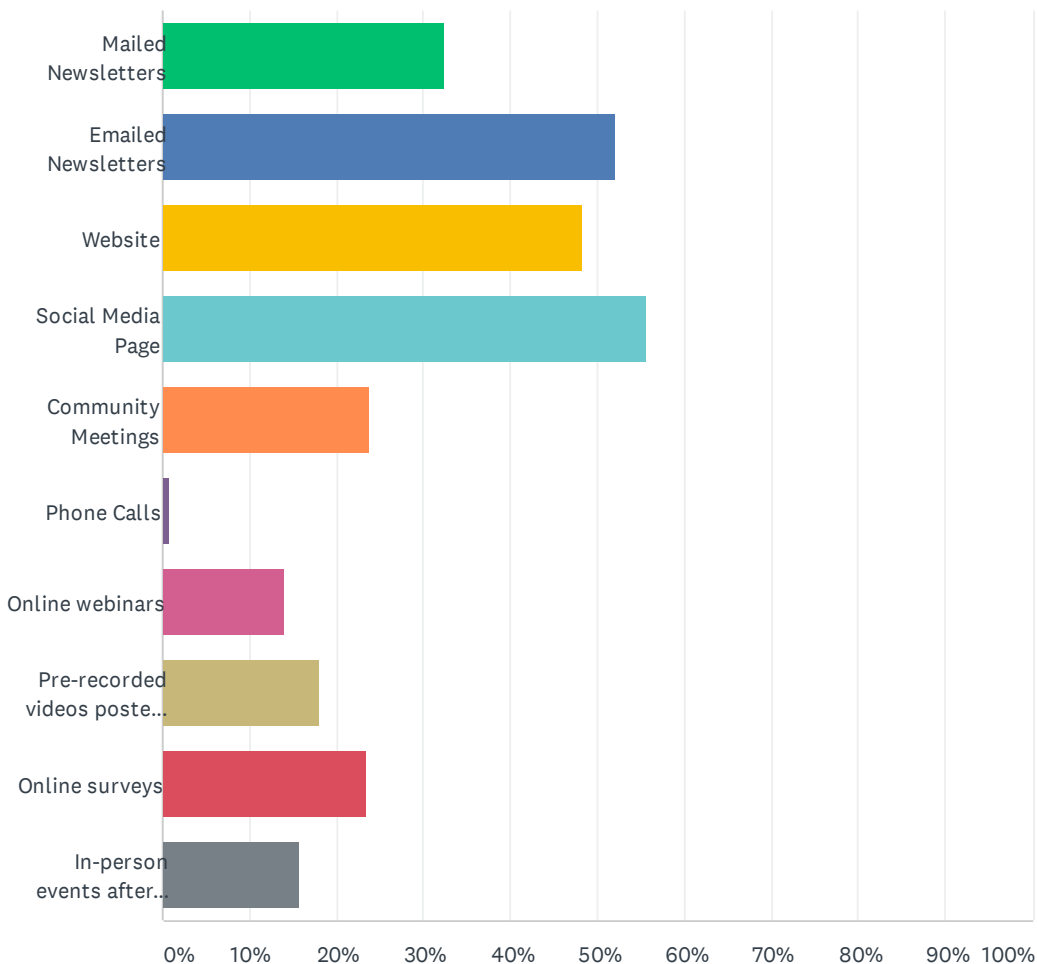

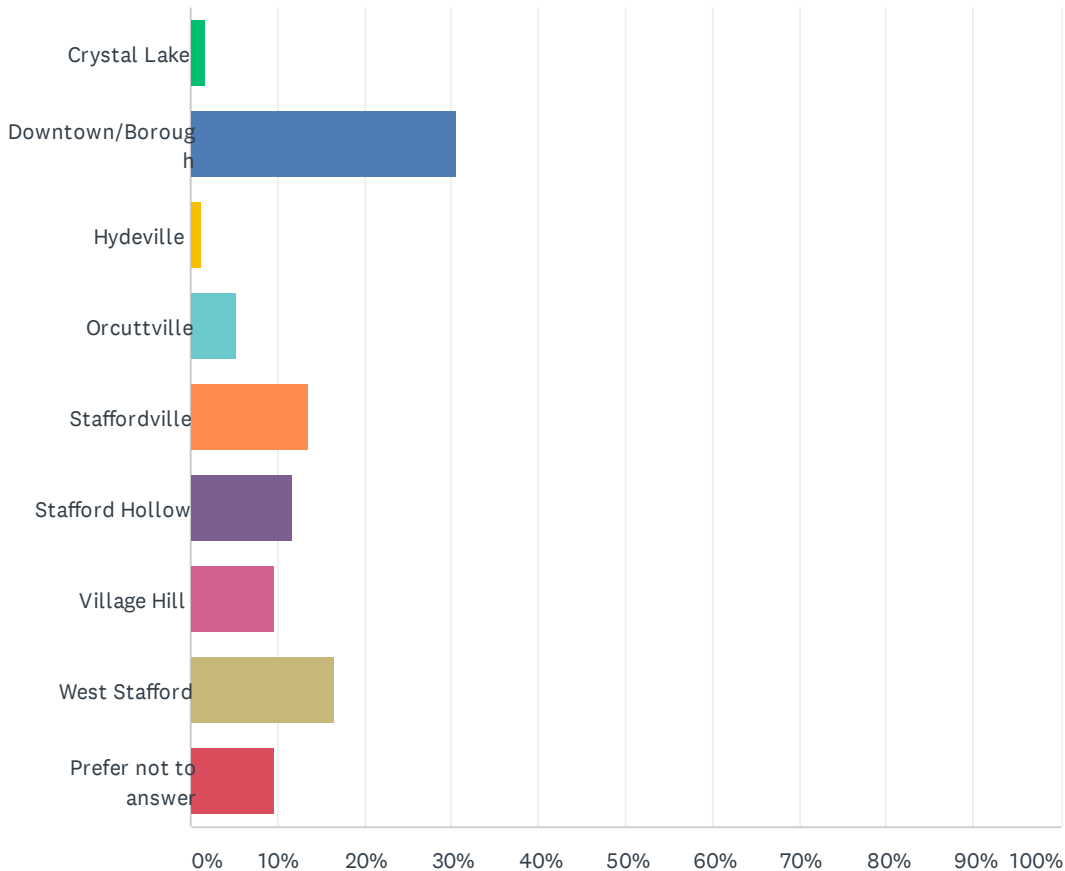

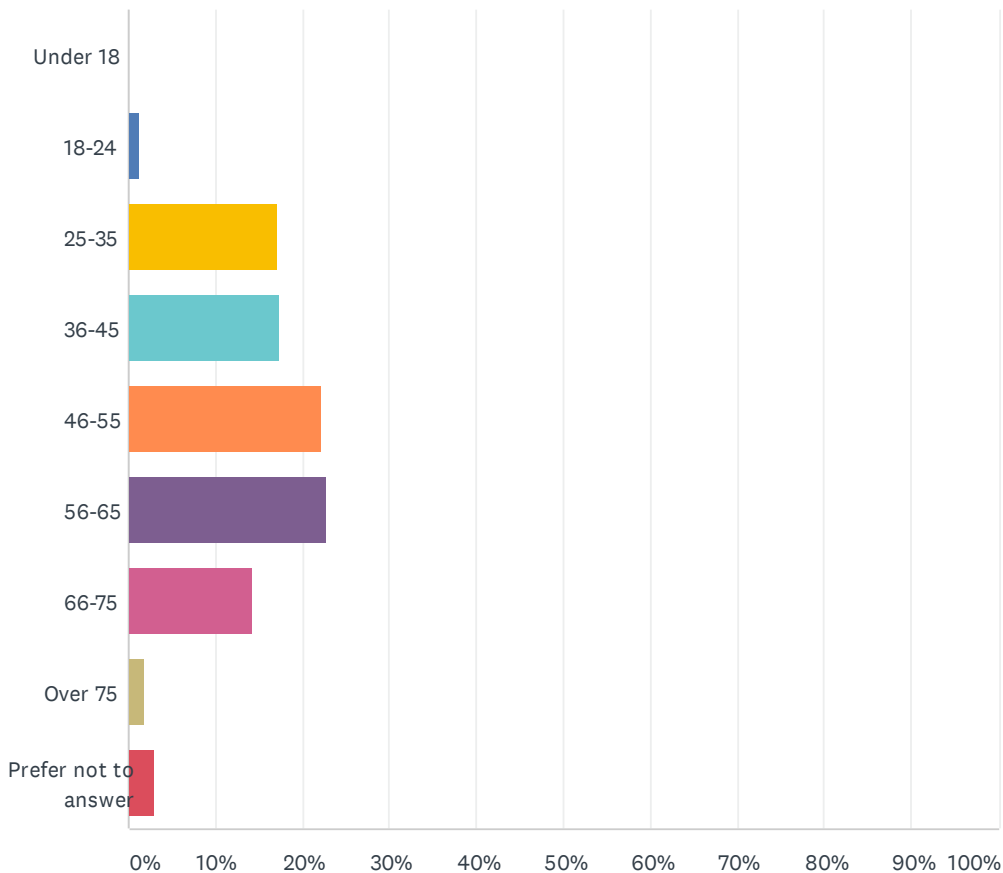

Q13 Please Select Your Age.

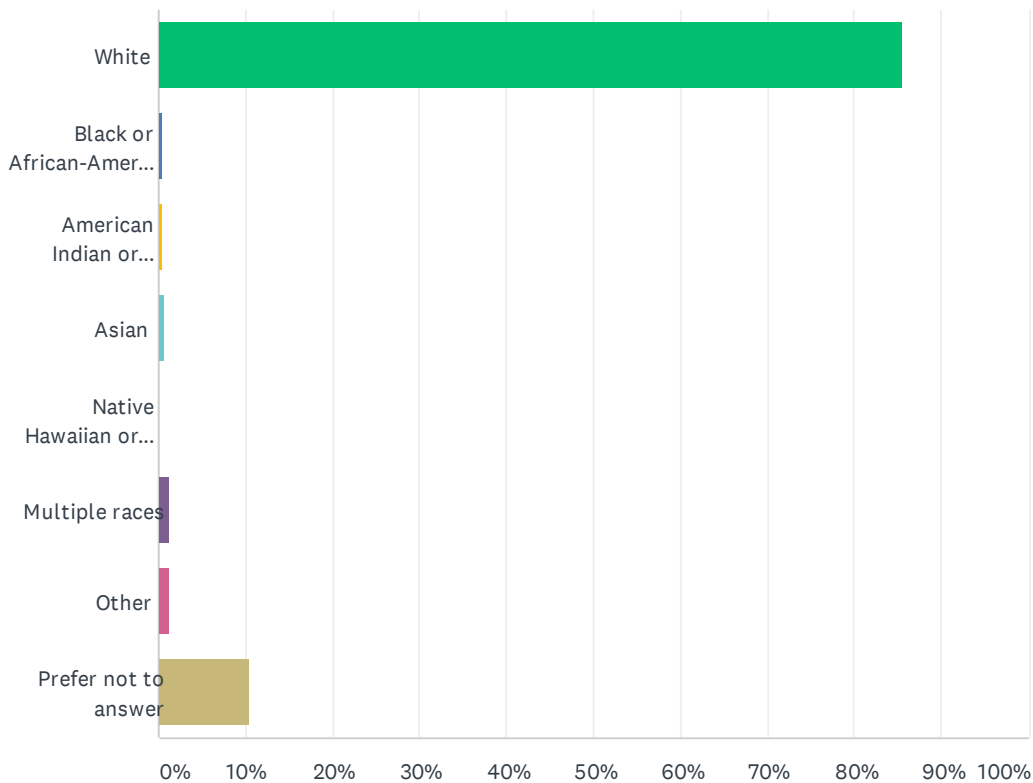

Q14 How would you describe yourself?

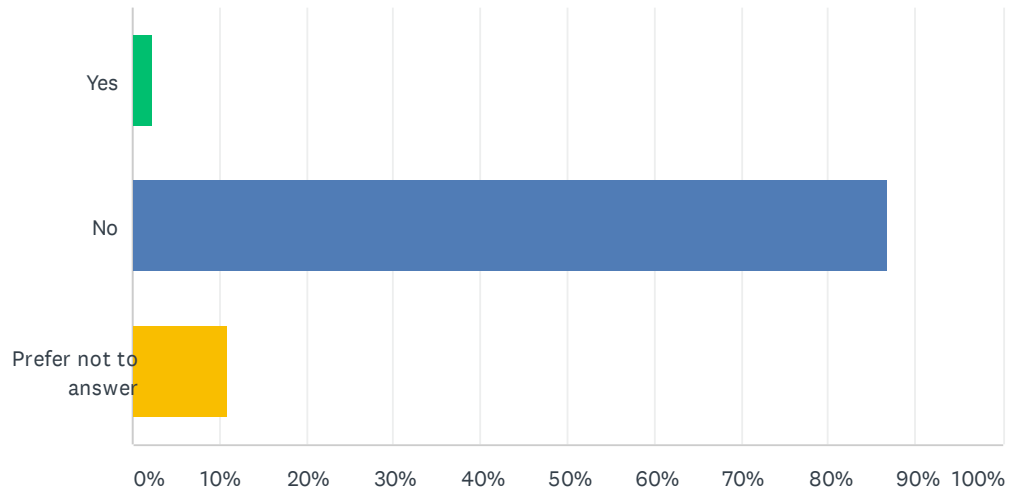
